

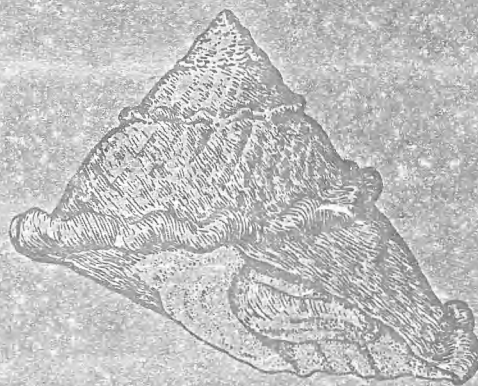

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A CATALOGUE OF COLLATIONS OF WORKS OF MALACOLOGICAL IMPORTANCE

Given the importance of priority in zoological nomenclature, the need for accurate dating of taxonomic works is undeniable. Many works, especially those published in parts over a span of several years, and many journals have been the subject of painstaking collations. Unfortunately, these collations are scattered widely through the literature, making their location difficult, and many are in specialty journals or catalogues, not available in most malacological libraries.

In order to draw together as much of this useful information as possible, we have assembled the list that follows. Since this material is so scattered, we have undoubtedly missed a number of significant collations. For these omissions, we offer our apologies and request that suggested additions be forwarded to us for future editions of this list.

We have organized the references alphabetically according to the author of the original work that is collated, or the title of the work itself if the work is without clear-cut authorship. In some instances, papers about the circumstances of publication and contents of important works are listed as well as papers containing collations.
