SIR,

I have the honour to submit, on behalf of the Fishery Board for Scotland, the Statistical Tables relating to the sea fisheries of Scotland for the year 1934. A narrative report on the fisheries and on the chief administrative and scientific activities of the Board during the year will shortly follow.

The Scottish fishing fleet in 1934 comprised 2,340 sailing vessels, 2,367 motor vessels, 686 steam drifters, 2 steam mussel dredgers, 25 steam liners as distinct from drifters, and 344 steam trawlers, or a total of 5,764 vessels, valued with their gear at £3,050,472, as against 5,794 vessels and £3,236,338 in 1933. In addition 271 English steam drifters fished in Scottish waters during the summer herring fishing. The number of Scottish fishermen was 22,601 (of whom 5,416 were crofter fishermen and 939 men were partially employed in fishing) as against 23,066 (including 5,590 crofter fishermen and 916 partially employed) in the preceding year. Shore workers and persons engaged in transport brought the total number employed in the Scottish fisheries to 56,929, as against 58,780 in 1933.

The total quantity of fish landed in Scotland by British fishing vessels during the year was 5,053,497 cwts., valued at £3,544,211, besides shell-fish valued at £92,404, as against 5,028,279 cwts., £3,518,905 and £94,025 respectively in 1933. In addition 242,109 cwts., valued at £131,535, were landed by foreign fishing vessels, mostly German trawlers engaged in the Icelandic fishing, as against 455,767 cwts. and £172,529 in the preceding year, making a grand total of 5,295,606 cwts., valued with shell-fish at £3,768,151, as compared with 5,484,046 cwts. and £3,785,459 in 1933. Herrings figured most prominently in the aggregate landings, contributing 2,490,525 cwts., valued at £833,480, against 2,256,379 cwts. and £1,129,149.

The total quantity of herrings cured, kippered, &c. amounted to 626,411 barrels (of which 480,678 were pickled gutted), valued after cure at £1,272,210, against a total of 601,258 barrels valued at £1,482,663 in 1933. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or drying, amounted after cure to 380,517 cwts., valued at £962,344, as against 446,560 cwts. and £986,137 in 1933.

The exports of fish from Scotland included 493,616 barrels of herrings gutted and pickled, 566 ungutted, and 89,798½ crans sprinkled with salt or iced, as against 455,193 barrels, none ungutted, and 87,863½ crans respectively in 1933, and 110,280 cwts. of dried, smoked, or pickled fish of various kinds, and 12,697 cwts. of fish preserved in other ways, as against 161,240 cwts. and 12,553 cwts. respectively in 1933.
