SIR,

I have the honour to submit, on behalf of the Fishery Board for Scotland, the Statistical Tables relating to the sea fisheries of Scotland for the year 1936. A narrative report on the fisheries and on the chief administrative and scientific activities of the Board during the year will shortly follow.

The Scottish fishing fleet in 1936 comprised 2,122 sailing vessels, 2,445 motor vessels, 536 steam drifters, 2 steam mussel dredgers, 24 steam liners as distinct from drifters, and 383 steam trawlers, or a total of 5,512 vessels, valued with their gear at £2,959,696, as against 5,657 vessels and £3,027,027 in 1935. In addition 275 English steam drifters fished in Scottish waters during the summer herring fishing. The number of Scottish fishermen was 21,480 (of whom 5,216 were crofter fishermen and 992 men were partially employed in fishing) as against 22,175 (including 5,369 crofter fishermen and 880 partially employed) in the preceding year. Shore workers and persons engaged in transport brought the total number employed in the Scottish fisheries to 58,506, as against 59,992 in 1935.

The total quantity of fish landed in Scotland by British fishing vessels during the year was 5,064,782 cwts., valued at £3,788,007, besides shell-fish valued at £89,923, as against 5,506,477 cwts., £3,852,112 and £91,625 respectively in 1935. In addition 142,654 cwts., valued at £111,509, were landed by foreign fishing vessels, mostly German trawlers and Swedish seiners, as against 218,084 cwts. and £124,581 in the preceding year, making a grand total of 5,208,436 cwts., valued with shell-fish at £3,989,446, as compared with 5,724,561 cwts. and £4,068,324 in 1935. Herrings figured most prominently in the aggregate landings, contributing 2,700,346 cwts., valued at £1,193,361, against 3,026,233 cwts. and £1,092,138 in the previous year.

The total quantity of herrings cured, kippered, &c. amounted to 673,536 barrels (of which 521,738 were pickled gutted), valued after cure at £1,590,621, against a total of 796,475 barrels valued at £1,628,613 in 1935. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or drying, amounted after cure to 363,712 cwts., valued at £863,896, as against 389,612 cwts. and £960,230 in 1935.

The exports of fish from Scotland included 516,447½ barrels of herrings gutted and pickled and 125,215 crans sprinkled with salt or iced, as against 620,508 barrels and 83,039 crans respectively in 1935, and 100,409 cwts. of dried, smoked, or pickled fish of various kinds, and 5,297 cwts. of fish preserved in other ways, as against 93,091 cwts. and 14,378 cwts. respectively in 1935.
