FOREWORD

Fish of British taking

United Kingdom

For the first time for many years landings of wet fish increased and last year's total of 15,718,000 cwts was some 804,000 cwts higher than in 1961. First-hand prices, however, fell and the total value realised in 1962 was £48,862,000 compared with £49,258,000 in the previous year. The value of shell fish continued to rise to £2,461,000.

England and Wales

The total quantity of wet fish landed in 1962 was 10,485,000 cwts compared with 9,981,000 cwts in 1961. At first-hand this increased catch realised £34,953,000 which was £689,000 less than in 1961.

Average prices in 1962 were generally lower for demersal fish. Except for sprats the average prices realised for pelagic fish increased. The average price for demersal fish fell by 5s. 8d. per cwt from 73s. 8d. to 68s. 0d. For pelagic fish there was a rise of 7s. 8d. from 30s. 1d. to 37s. 9d. resulting in a fall of 4s. 9d. per cwt from 71s. 5d. to 66s. 8d. for all wet fish.

The value of shell fish landed decreased by £67,000 to £1,068,000.

Demersal landings

The decline in the catch of demersal fish halted. Landings in 1962 were 10,019,000 cwts compared with 9,440,000 cwts in 1961. The weight of cod landings remained at over one-half of the total catch with an increase of 11 per cent in 1961 to 5,518,000 cwts in 1962. Landings of haddock rose by 2 per cent to 1,644,000 cwts, of plaice by 2 per cent to 595,000 cwts, and of redfish by 11 per cent to 335,000 cwts. The landings of saithe (449,000 cwts) decreased by 5 per cent and of hake (140,000 cwts) by 3 per cent.

Pelagic landings

Landings of pelagic fish amounted to 466,000 cwts in 1962 compared with 541,000 cwts in the previous year. Herrings accounted for 272,000 cwts compared with 372,000 cwts in 1961. Sprat landings increased from 81,000 cwts to 121,000 cwts.

Imports

Imports of fish in 1962 totalled 4,296,000 cwts valued at £60,290,000 compared with 4,021,000 cwts valued at £42,860,000 in 1961. This increase was due mainly to imports of canned fish, principally salmon, which rose by £16,738,000 while imports of fresh, chilled and frozen fish fell by £648,000.

Japan supplied canned fish to the value of £25,506,000 out of a total of £39,746,000, with Canada as the second most important source (£3,573,000). Denmark and Norway remained the principal suppliers of fresh, chilled and frozen fish.

Imports of whale meat and meals and oils made from fish and marine animals increased from £22,935,000 to £25,086,000.

Exports

The weight of fish exported rose from 751,000 cwts in 1961 to 861,000 cwts in 1962 and the value rose by £688,000 to £7,055,000. The main markets for British fish products were Australia, Belgium, France and the United States of America.

Exports of meals and oils made from fish and marine animals amounted to 149,000 cwts valued at £678,000 in 1962 compared with 229,000 cwts valued at £1,042,000 in 1961.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The different kinds of fish are divided into three main groups: Demersal, Pelagic and Shell fish. The names of the kinds of fish included under each group are shown in Table 2.

Place of Capture (see Tables 4, 5 and 6). The fishing grounds are divided into statistical regions. These regions are generally grouped as follows:

"Distant Waters" include the Barents Sea and waters adjacent to Bear Island, Spitzbergen, Greenland, Iceland, Labrador, Newfoundland, and the waters off the coasts of Norway and Portugal.

"Near and Middle Waters" comprise the North Sea, the Irish Sea, Bristol and English Channels, and waters adjacent to the Faroes, Rockall, the West of Scotland and the West and South of Ireland. The catch recorded from these waters does not, however, include any landed by vessels under 40 feet in registered length.

"Inshore" (Table 6). All landings by vessels under 40 feet in length are so described.

"Deep Sea Landings" (Table 4). Includes catches of all vessels of 40 feet and over in length. Values shown are as realised at first-hand sale.

All tables refer to landings by British registered fishing vessels unless otherwise indicated.
