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FOREWORD

FISH OF BRITISH TAKING

United Kingdom

Landings of wet fish increased, for the third year running. The total in 1964 was 16,341,000 cwts, or 126,000 cwts more than in 1963. This increase was due to heavier landings in Scotland: landings in England and Wales decreased. The value of the catch increased by £3,225,000 to a record level of £54,286,000. The value of shellfish landings continued to rise to £2,945,000.

England and Wales

The quantity of wet fish landed in 1964 was 9,955,000 cwts compared with 10,237,000 cwts in 1963. At first hand sale this somewhat smaller catch realised £38,160,000 which was £1,928,000 more than in 1963. The average price of all wet fish rose by 5s. 11d. per cwt from 70s. 9d. to 76s. 8d. Prices were higher in 1964 for demersal fish, the average rising by 6s. 7d. per cwt to 80s. 4d., but lower for pelagic fish, the average price of which fell from 29s. 9d. to 29s. 2d. per cwt. The value of shellfish landings which had been falling since 1961, rose by £191,000 to a record level of £1,220,000.

Demersal Landings

There was a further decline in the quantity of demersal fish landed in England and Wales. Landings in 1964 were 9,243,000 cwts compared with 9,554,000 cwts in 1963. Cod continued to account for over half of the total catch but landings decreased by 8 per cent on 1963 to a total of 4,978,000 cwts in 1964. Haddock landings showed little change and landings of plaice increased by 2 per cent to 697,000 cwts. Supplies of saithe increased by 36 per cent to 645,000 cwts and those of redfish fell slightly. Landings of hake (105,000 cwts) showed a decrease of 15 per cent.

Pelagic Landings

The landings of pelagic fish in England and Wales increased from 683,000 cwts in 1963 to 712,000 cwts in 1964. This was due to heavier catches of sprats (285,000 cwts in 1964 compared with 123,000 cwts in 1963) which more than offset the decline in herring landings from 481,000 cwts in 1963 to 352,000 cwts in 1964.

IMPORTS

Imports of fish into the U.K. in 1964 totalled 4,499,000 cwts valued at £66,878,000 compared with 3,791,000 cwts valued at £49,925,000 in 1963. Two-thirds of this increase was in canned fish (principally salmon) which increased by £10,866,000. Most of the remaining increase was in fresh, chilled and frozen fish, imports of which increased by £4,751,000 or about 30 per cent. More than half of this increase was in frozen fillet imports which rose by £2,662,000 or just over 50 per cent.

Japan remained the principal supplier of canned fish, with £20,799,000 out of a total of £40,475,000 and Canada the second, with £5,356,000. Denmark and Norway remained the principal suppliers, by value, of fresh, chilled and frozen fish.

Imports of whale meat and meals and oils made from fish and marine animals increased from £23,787,000 to £33,665,000.

EXPORTS

Exports from the U.K. of fish and fish products, other than meals and oils, fell from 884,000 cwts in 1963 to 849,000 cwts in 1964 but their value rose from £7,677,000 to £8,177,000. This increase in value was due to exports of fresh and simply preserved shellfish, which increased by £257,000, and exports of preserved and canned fish products, which increased by £351,000. Both the quantity and value of wet fish exports fell. Australia and France remained the main markets for British fish products, France taking much of our shellfish. Belgium, the Netherlands, the Irish Republic and the United States of America also provided important markets. Exports of meals and oils made from fish and marine animals amounted to 200,000 cwts valued at £941,000 in 1964, compared with 221,000 cwts valued at £804,000 in 1963.

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

The different kinds of fish are divided into three main groups: Demersal, Pelagic and Shellfish. The names of the kinds of fish included under each group are shown in Table 2. "Livers of Fish" include the raw equivalent of any liver oils landed.

Values shown are as realised at first-hand sale.

All tables refer to landings by British registered fishing vessels unless otherwise indicated.

Place of Capture (see Tables 4, 5 and 6). The fishing grounds are divided into statistical regions (Tables 4 and 5) and are generally grouped (Table 6) as follows:—

"Distant Waters" include Regions I, II, Va, XIV of the I.C.E.S. Statistical Area (North) and the whole of the I.C.N.A.F. Statistical Area.

"Near and Middle Waters" comprise Regions IIIa, IV, Vb, VI and VII of the I.C.E.S. Statistical Area (North), but the catch by vessels of under 40 feet registered length within these waters is described as "Inshore".

"Deep Sea Landings" (Table 4). Includes catches of all vessels of 40 feet and over registered length.
