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FOREWORD

The Sea Fisheries Statistics for 1976 largely follow the layout of the 1975 publication, but, in accordance with the gradual transition to metric units, quantities of fish and fish products are now shown in the metric unit of tonnes. Where appropriate, figures for earlier years have been converted to this metric unit. Classification of vessel lengths; gross registered tonnage of vessels remain in imperial units. The tables refer, as far as possible, to the United Kingdom with separate figures for England and Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. Additional statistics relating to Scotland are published annually in the Scottish Sea Fisheries Statistical Tables.

In some cases figures for the various parts of the United Kingdom are not strictly comparable and differences are explained in the headings and footnotes of the tables. More general definitions are given in the Explanatory Notes on Page 1.

These tables are intended to provide a broad picture of the United Kingdom fishing industry and its operations. Requests for more detailed information should be addressed to:—

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. The various species of fish are divided into three main groups: demersal, pelagic and shellfish. The names of the kinds of fish included in each group, are shown in table 2.
2. The term "demersal" fish covers species living on or near the sea bed; "pelagic" fish are species found mainly in coastal waters in shoals near the surface of the sea.
3. The quantities shown in the tables 1 to 11 are in terms of landed weight. For the pelagic species and for Norway Pout, Redfish and Sandeels this means an ungutted weight. For all the other demersal species it is generally the head-on gutted weight. Filleted-at-sea fish are also included in terms of equivalent landed weight (as appropriate). The trade tables (17 et seq) show actual product weight.
4. The figures of "fish livers" are expressed as the raw equivalent of any liver oils landed.
5. The average values of fish quoted in table 11 are those realised at first-hand sales and apply to all fish sold regardless of whether it was sold for human consumption or for other uses (e.g. fish meal, animal feeding stuffs).
6. The term "British landings" relates to the landings of British registered fishing vessels.
7. The sign . . . indicates a quantity of less than 0.5 tonne or a value less than £500 according to the table.
