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1.0 Introduction

WP 9 of MERMAID aims to disseminate project knowledge and procedures into the community of users. In this context the "users" are essentially the professionals involved in the planning, installation, operation, maintenance, monitoring and decommissioning of off-shore platforms, the preparation and implementation of policies and strategies for sustainable use of sea resources, low carbon economy and eco-friendly transportation. Specific activities are also planned for the "users" as the ultimate beneficiaries of the research, i.e. the public and businesses which receive benefits from a sustainable development of the use of marine resources, both energy and food.

The overall objectives of the project dissemination task are to:

- to establish an efficacious collaboration and exchange of knowledge, information and experiences between the scientific community, coastal and marine authorities, the industry and potential end users
- to disseminate to the scientific community, authorities and potential end users the results of the project
- To inform the public at large and relevant end users and stakeholders about the concept of multi-use offshore platforms and to create awareness among the public

The main dissemination activities include:

- the participation in international exhibitions: production of materials e.g. posters, leaflets, etc.
- the establishment and updating of the project home page on the World Wide Web;
- the publication of peer-reviewed scientific papers;
- the active participation of partners in international conferences and publications in the proceedings of these conferences;
- the publication of guidelines, based upon the project findings, that present performance and design of innovative multi-purpose platforms;
- the results of MERMAID are expected to be used in teaching assignments, lectures and exercises at European universities so that the latest state-of-the-art is given to European students;
- the utilization of results in PhD studies in scientific publications and thesis

1.1 Objectives

The mid-term dissemination report gives a comprehensive overview of the activities and results performed between Month 1 and 24 of the project. The results will be discussed per worktask. For each worktask, we will provide an overview and assessment of the task performed and will discuss planned actions or strategy.

2.0 Description of the performed activities between M1 and M24

2.1. Website

A Project Internet website was set up at month 4 of the project (MS 38). The website is available at http://www.mermaidproject.eu. During the project, the website will be continuously updated with new material. The web-site hosts a free access area containing project official deliverables, leaflets, research news, discussions, abstracts, papers (also the papers published in international conferences and journals, in respect of the Special Clause 39 to be included). The web site also includes videos and selected pictures showcasing to the public at large the activities performed within MERMAID.

The Website contains: the project "Description of Work", updates, news and project reports, issues regarding dissemination of results, reports and publications, Document management system, A picture and movie gallery, Contact information on the project consortium, Links to the publications (WT9.2) end-user conference (WT9.6), DVD(WP9.3), Coastal and Marine Wiki information pages (WT9.4).

The Project web-site became an important tool for information management of the project. The www server contains a password protected areas accessible to partners for data exchanging. The website was developed as a Content Management System (CMS) allowing remote information entry by different project partners. All partners can also upload important dissemination activities (press releases, presentations, publications and conferences).

Currently, the website receives about 3000 unique visitors a month. The table below shows the number of unique visitors, number of visits, pages and hits per month since the launch of the website.

2.2. Publications

- A project leaflet was produced at the first phase of the project. This project leaflet gives a general introduction and outline of the project, project objectives and partners involved. It also refers to the other projects funded under the same call. The leaflet has been printed on 3000 copies, and almost half of them are currently been distributed. They were distributed to all project partners and disseminated during several local, national and international for a and conferences. The leaflet is also available in digital format form the website.
- A poster presentation has been created and is available in digital format form the website.
- A coastal booklet is under construction, and almost finalized. It gives provides detailed
 information about the project objectives and the challenges being faced at the different
 studysites. Input from all the site managers was compiled to provide an accessible
 information booklet, targeting professional end users and policy makers. The booklet will be
 printed on 5000 copies and will be launched, together with the dissemination DVD.
- Scientific publications produced by the project partners are progressively posted on the project web-site. So far 9 A1 publications have been published or submitted. For a complete overview of the publications, poster and oral presentations, see Annex I.

2.3. Production of a dissemination movie

An important activity of WP9 during M1-M24 was the creation of a promotional DVD "Innovative Multi-use Offshore Platforms: planning, design & operation". The short dissemination film of 10 minutes on multi-use offshore platforms for Europe will include facts (from project partners) and interviews with science, industry and different stakeholders.

Five different shootings have been realized:

- an interview with all WP leaders in Delft during a general meeting
- filming of Salmon aquaculture and interviewing local stakeholders at Bergen,
- filming facilities at Statoil in Bergen
- filming if the project coordinator in Copenhagen, and filming the Danish coast.
- on June 20th 2013, the European Commissioner for Research and Innovation, Máire Geoghegan-Quinn, was interviewed. The Commissioner highlighted the contribution of the MERMAID project to the development of a thriving maritime economy, in an environmentally sustainable manner. Furthermore, Commissioner Geoghegan-Quinn stressed the importance of the smart use of marine space and making offshore

- platforms economically viable. The Commissioner highly appreciated the multidisciplinary approach of the MERMAID project, as well as the interaction with partners from industry and stakeholders.
- the DVD includes also a conceptual design and animation of MUP at different study sites

All the interviews are now, incorporated in the MERMAID dissemination movie and will undoubtedly add to the strategic importance of the MERMAID concept. There will be a press release when the DVD will be released. We explore the possibilities to release the DVD during a high level event, linked to MUPs.

2.4. Translation project outcomes into Coastal and Marine Wiki articles

Project results will be translated for a large public into accessible quality controlled information pages on the Coastal and Marine Wiki. By using the Coastal and marine Wiki, the project results will be exploited through the web as much as possible. The Coastal and Marine Wiki is an Internet encyclopaedia of almost 1500 information pages for and by coastal professionals providing up-to-date high quality Coastal and Marine information.

So far one deliverable has been translated in an Wiki Article: "The Legal and Policy context of Multi-use Offshore Platforms". It has been accessed 1646 times.

2.5. Networking, and knowledge management

Different MERMAID related networking activities have been performed. The annex I gives an overview of all paper, poster or oral presentations that have been performed at different national and international conferences. For a complete overview see Annex.

2.6. End user conference

Within this work task, an high-level international end-conference on Multi Use Offshore Platforms will be organized. It was decided to held the conference in Brussels at the end of the project (month 48). The conference will build upon the European expertise and results obtained within the framework of the project MERMAID. It will mainly target project partners, other scientists, SME's, the industry and

policy-makers. It aims to increase public awareness of the possibilities and challenges of constructing Multi Use platforms and to disseminate the project results as widely as possible.

Furthermore, press-actions will be set up in order to promote the conference as widely as possible. The conference will be organized with support from the Marine Board of the European Science Foundation and other relevant institutions, assuring the participation of as many European policymakers as possible. An active link with and the involvement of MERMAID end-users within the process will seek to maximally exploit the project results.

The organization of the end-conference includes the following steps (with indicative timing, based on an end-conference being organized in month 36):

 Decision was made that we could not organize the end conferences of MERMAID, H2OCEAN and TROPOS jointly, because the projects do not end at the same time (MERMAID is a four year project, TROPS and H2OCEAN in a three year project).

- End-conference & media-actions (March 2015)
