The next SC will take place in Barcelona on the 4-6th of September 2013.

The Pegaso EU Project Officer will attend this meeting.

The progress of work and the Deliverable Plans for each WP will be revised together with the quality control process to be organized through the Third Virtual Conference (VIC03) in November - December 2013.

The Pegaso Calendar of the project will also be discussed; mainly the ICPC training workshops and the Final Conference in Antalya.

A slot in the agenda will focus on the option (if there are resources available) to produce promotional videos within the CASEs and a proposal of the content.

During the second day of the meeting, the main Pegaso S&T results and potential impact will be presented to Mr Stefan WEIERS, the new project officer responsible for the project (replacing Ariana NASTASEANU), who will explain to the members of the SC the EU final technical review process.

During the third day of the meeting, the second round of polimedia videos will be produced: ICZM process, Indicators, Participatory Methods, Economic Assessment and IRA, to feed the Pegaso on-line training materials.

The ICPC Training Workshops Calendar

The following ICPC workshops have been scheduled to be organized in the following months:

“Nile Delta northern lakes investment scenarios for restoration actions in an ICZM frame”

Cairo, 28-29th September 2013.

Objective: How to secure aquaculture sustainable development of Nile Delta in an ICZM frame.

Status: Closed programme (IFREMER and NIOF).

(RISK: Pending of political stability).

“Aquaculture in the Greek Islands in an ICZM frame”

Athens, October 2013 to be confirmed.

Objective: to think on the prospective of aquaculture in an ICZM frame for local development.

Status: under discussion (IFREMER and HCMR).

“Training on indicators and LEAC for ICZM implementation in Georgia (the Guria CASE)”

October 2013, to be confirmed.

Objective: Combining the work

done on indicators in the CASE with the Pegaso indicators, production of factsheets, use of the SDI and GIS.

Status: under discussion with BSC PS.

“Workshop and training on indicators and LEAC for ICZM implementation, MPAs and aquaculture in Algeria, Morocco and Tunisia”

11-16 November 2013 to be confirmed.

Objective: Using the Pegaso indicators for ICZM in Magreb.

Status: under discussion with AREA ED.

The ICPC workshops are mainly organised to train trainers and disseminate results through technical notes (one for each workshop) and in the most relevant languages (French, Arabic, English, Turkish and Russian).

Workshop on Pegaso Integrated Regional Assessment (September 2013)

The Pegaso IRA made a good progress in Rabat and also in a recent meeting in Sevilla (Technical Meeting WP3-4-5 on the 28-19th May 2013) where the availability of spatial information for the IRA was

explored. The calendar for the next months continues with a proposal of a meeting to discuss about the preliminary results of the Pegaso Integrated Regional Assessment as a basis for developing guidelines for ICZM implementation in the Mediterranean and Black Sea, back-to-back with the Coast Day that this year will be held in Rimini, Italy on the 25th of September.
