

## Master of Science in Marine and Lacustrine Science and Management

### Oceans & Lakes

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The 2-year master programme “Master of Science in Marine and Lacustrine Science and Management” (in short: “Oceans & Lakes”) addresses students with a background in Sciences. Oceans & Lakes is an interuniversity programme organized by the Faculty of Sciences of Vrije Universiteit Brussel, Universiteit Antwerpen and Universiteit Gent. It provides students with strong fundamental and applied knowledge and prepares them for an active role in scientific research and management of marine and lacustrine systems. The programme provides insight into the diversity and complexity of life and processes in oceans, lakes and estuaries. It adopts a multidisciplinary approach integrating physical, chemical geological, ecological and societal aspects and including nature conservation and sustainable development. Oceans & Lakes is open to holders of a bachelor’s degree in biology, biochemistry and biotechnology, chemistry, geology, geography, geomorphology and geomatics, bio-engineering or environmental sciences.

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
