
## Which species are on the list

- All known non-indigenous species with established populations in marine and brackish waters
- Cryptogenic species
- Species (un)intentionally introduced by man
- Species shown to be ***invasive*** (\*). Invasiveness may be defined either from ecological or socio-economic perspective

## Which species are not on the list


- Vagrant species
- Fresh water species
- Species arriving by natural dispersion, e.g. as a consequence of climate change








Increase in first observations of alien species, from 1970's

Number alien species increased from 32 to 73 (1990-2013)

Literature screening and reported evidence suggest 14 species are 'invasive' in the BNS or in the adjacent waters. Of these, 6 are arthropods
