FOREWORD

Fish of British taking

United Kingdom

Landings of wet fish which declined for many years until 1961 increased in 1962 and again in 1963 when the total was 16,215,000 cwts, nearly 500,000 cwts more than in 1962. This increase was entirely due to heavier Scottish landings. In 1962, prices and the total value of the catch fell. In 1963, prices rose and the value of the catch increased by £2,199,000 to a record level of £51,061,000. The value of shell fish landings continued to rise to £2,522,000.

England and Wales

The quantity of wet fish landed in 1963 was 10,237,000 cwts compared with 10,485,000 cwts in 1962. At first hand sale this somewhat smaller catch realised £36,232,000 which was £1,279,000 more than in 1962.

Prices in 1963 were generally higher for demersal fish, rising on average by 5s. 9d. per cwt from 68s. 0d. to 73s. 9d. Except for sprats, prices realised by pelagic fish decreased, falling on average by 8s. 0d. per cwt from 37s. 9d. to 29s. 9d. per cwt. For all wet fish the average price rose by 4s. 1d. per cwt from 66s. 8d. to 70s. 9d.

The value of shell fish landed decreased by £39,000 to £1,029,000.

Demersal Landings

The catch of demersal fish declined but was still greater than in 1961. Landings in 1963 were 9,554,000 cwts compared with 10,019,000 cwts in 1962. The weight of cod landed was over one-half of the total catch with a decrease of 2 per cent on 1962 to a total of 5,409,000 cwts in 1963. Landings of haddock decreased by 27 per cent to 1,208,000 cwts and of hake by 11 per cent to 124,000 cwts. Redfish landings hardly altered and the landings of plaice (683,000 cwts) and saithe (476,000 cwts) showed increases of 15 per cent and 6 per cent respectively.

Pelagic Landings

Landings of pelagic fish increased substantially to 683,000 cwts in 1963 compared with 466,000 cwts in the previous year. This was mainly due to heavier catches of herring, which accounted for 481,000 cwts compared with 272,000 cwts in 1962. Sprat landings rose slightly from 121,000 cwts to 123,000 cwts.

Imports

Imports of fish in 1963 totalled 3,789,000 cwts valued at £49,871,000 compared with 4,296,000 cwts valued at £60,298,000 in 1962. This decrease was almost entirely in imports of canned fish, principally salmon, which declined by £10,178,000.

Japan supplied canned fish to a total of £16,168,000 out of a total of £29,569,000 with Canada as the second most important source (£3,598,000). In terms of value Denmark and Norway remained the principal suppliers of fresh, chilled and frozen fish.

Imports of whale meat and meals and oils made from fish and marine animals probably decreased slightly although, as a consequence of changes in classifications introduced in 1963, the imports of Other Oils are not directly comparable over the years 1962 and 1963. The changes followed a decision to classify the external trade statistics of the United Kingdom within the framework of Standard International Trade Classification, Revised, of the United Nations (S.I.T.C. Revised), which provides headings corresponding directly with those of the Brussels Tariff Nomenclature.

Exports

The weight of fish exported rose from 862,000 cwts in 1962 to 885,000 cwts in 1963 and the value rose from £7,073,000 to £7,673,000. The main markets for British fish products were Australia and France. Belgium, the Irish Republic, Italy and the United States of America also provided important markets.

Exports of meals and oils made from fish and marine animals amounted to 221,000 cwts valued at £804,000 in 1963, compared with 169,000 cwts valued at £694,000 in 1962. As for imports, the figures for Oils are not exactly comparable.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The different kinds of fish are divided into three main groups: Demersal, Pelagic and Shell fish. The names of the kinds of fish included under each group are shown in Table 2.

Place of Capture (see Tables 4, 5 and 6). The fishing grounds are divided into statistical regions. These regions are generally grouped as follows:

"Distant Waters" include the Barents Sea and waters adjacent to Bear Island, Spitzbergen, Greenland, Iceland, Labrador, Newfoundland, and the waters off the coasts of Norway and Portugal.

"Near and Middle Waters" comprise the North Sea, the Irish Sea, Bristol and English Channels, and waters adjacent to the Faroes, Rockall, the West of Scotland and the West and South of Ireland. The catch recorded from these waters does not, however, include any landed by vessels under 40 feet in registered length.

"Inshore" (Table 6). All landings by vessels under 40 feet in length are so described.

"Deep Sea Landings" (Table 4). Includes catches of all vessels of 40 feet and over in length. Values shown are as realised at first-hand sale.

All tables refer to landings by British registered fishing vessels unless otherwise indicated.
