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## FOREWORD


The Sea Fisheries Statistics for 1990 mainly follow the layout of the 1989 publication. Where appropriate figures for earlier years have been converted into metric units. The tables refer, as far as possible, to the United Kingdom, with separate figures for England and Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. Additional statistics relating to Scotland are published annually in the Scottish Sea Fisheries Statistical Tables.

In some cases figures for the various parts of the United Kingdom are not strictly comparable and differences are explained in the headings and footnotes of the tables. More general definitions are given in the Explanatory Notes on page 1.



## EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. The various species of fish are divided into three main groups: demersal, pelagic and shellfish. The names of the kinds of fish included in each group are shown in table 2.
2. The term "demersal" fish covers species living on or near the sea bed; "pelagic" fish are species found mainly in coastal waters in shoals near the surface of the sea. The term "wet fish" is used to denote both demersal and pelagic species.
3. Quantities of whole, headless or filleted-at-sea fish landed by British and foreign fishing vessels are shown in terms of equivalent landed weight for the most common form of presentation (head on, gutted for most species) except in the trade tables (17 et seq) where actual product weights are shown, and in the area of capture tables (6) where liveweight is shown.
4. The term "British landings" relates to the landings of British registered fishing vessels.
5. Mackeral and herring landing figures for 1978 - 1990 include a quantity caught by British vessels but not actually landing at British Ports. These quantities are trans-shipped to foreign vessels in coastal waters and are later recorded as exports.
6. The sign .. indicates a quantity of less than 0.5 tonne or a value less than £500 according to the table.
7. Difficulties in collecting complete statistics on shellfish landings mean that available figures may significantly underestimate the total landings in some instances. The figures are however thought to be broadly indicative of trends.
