Abstract: Six species belonging to the family Macridae known to occur in the waters of East Sinai are illustrated.

Six species belonging to the family Macridae and found in the waters of East Sinai are listed in the table and illustrated below. The three species belonging to the genus *Mactra* are shallow water species. The *Mactrinula* and *Mactrotoma* species are only known from dredgings.
