

2. Travel information

At your arrival, you will receive a pass for all public transport. This pass will be valid on all metro and bus lines for 48 hours (starting at 17h30 on day 1).

In the email of confirmation, you have also received a map of the Berlin public transport (only underground trains, no busses listed on that map) as a pdf. <u>Please note</u> that important construction work on the U6 metro line is interrupting the traffic. Please check the suggested options to reach the venue, see below.

Stations nearby the Jerusalemkirche are:

Subway **U1**, station "Hallesches Tor" (10-15 mins walk to Jerusalemkirche) Subway **U6**, station "Kochstrasse" (10 mins walk to Jerusalemkirche) Bus **M29** and Bus **248**, station "Lindenstr./Oranienstr." (5 mins walk to Jerusalemkirche)

a) From the Central Station ("Hauptbahnhof") to the conference venue

There are mainly 3 options to reach Jerusalemkirche from the Central Station:

Option 1:

Bus M41 (direction: "Sonnenallee/Baumschulenstr.") to "Anhalter Bahnhof"

then

Bus M29 (direction: "Hermannplatz") to "Lindenstr./Oranienstr."

Option 2:

\$75 (direction: "Wartenberg") to "Alexanderplatz"

walk about 5mins to "Alexanderplatz Bhf/Grunerstr"., then

Bus 248 (direction: "Breitenbachplatz", via Südkreuz) to "Lindenstr./Oranienstr."

Option 3:

\$5/\$7/\$75 from "Hauptbahnhof" to "Friedrichstraße"

U6 (direction "Alt-Mariendorf") to "Kochstraße" → **BUT**: the U6 subway line is **interrupted due to construction work** (see Berlin subway map). You would therefore have to walk from "Friedrichstraße" to the next U6 stop ("Französische Straße").

b) from airport Schönefeld (SXF):

To the central station by airport express:

Between 4.30 a.m. and 11 p.m. the regional trains RE7 and RB14 called "Airport Express", travel in 30 minute intervals between Schönefeld Airport and Berlin-Charlottenburg with stops at "Ostbahnhof", "Alexanderplatz", Berlin Central Station ("Hauptbahnhof") and "Zoologischer Garten". It takes about 15 minutes to get to "Ostbahnhof" with the Airport Express and 30 minutes to get to Berlin Central Station ("Hauptbahnhof").

Note: Schönefeld Airport is located in fare zone C. To get to the city center an ABC ticket is required.

To the central station by regular public transport:

From the train station at Schönefeld Airport the S-Bahn lines S9 and S45 run to the city center. Travellers who want to get to Berlin Central Station ("Hauptbahnhof") can take the S9 until the station "Ostkreuz" and then change to the S-Bahn lines S3, S5, S7 or S75 which stop at Central Station ("Hauptbahnhof").

To Jerusalemkirche by taxi:

A taxi from Schönefeld airport to the Jerusalemkirche will roughly cost 40€. Note: taxi drivers in Germany usually expect a tip of around 10% of the fare.

c) from airport Tegel (TXL)

Tegel Airport has no direct link to the S-or U-Bahn (subway), but is connected through busses.

To the central station by TXL Express Bus

The TXL bus travels in five-or ten-minute intervals between Tegel Airport and "Alexanderplatz" (via Berlin Central Station "Hauptbahnhof"), and leaves right in front of the terminal. Depending on the time of day the ride from the airport to Berlin Central Station ("Hauptbahnhof") takes around 30 minutes.

To Jerusalemkirche by taxi:

A taxi from Tegel airport to the Jerusalemkirche will roughly cost 30€.

Note: taxi drivers in Germany usually expect a tip of around 10% of the fare.

Carolin's favourite restaurant: Beijte Ethiopia

Said to be Berlin's most authentic Ethiopian restaurant. Holds an Ethiopian coffee ceremony nightly at 8pm. If the weather is warm, you can sit in the beer garden under trees.

How to get there:

from the conference venue, walk 10-15 mins to the subway (U-Bahn) station "Hallesches Tor". From there, take the **U1** (direction "Uhlandstrasse") to the station "Nollendorfplatz", and walk 2 minutes to the Bejte Ethiopia in Zietenstrasse 8 (see map).



Marie's favourite restaurant: Sauvage

Perfect time-travel after the dinner with the dinosaurs at the Natural history Museum, the restaurant Sauvage is the first Paleolithic restaurant in the whole world. There you will be acquainted with the Paleo Cuisine, which is based on "the dietary habits of our prehistoric ancestors, but does not mimic how prehistoric man ate. The modern Paleo cook combines evolutionary science with contemporary cuisine and ancestral cooking methods. The Prehistoric Kitchen works exclusively with natural, unprocessed foods, excluding any processed ingredients developed after the start of agriculture." The staffs are extremely friendly and will answer all your questions on the principles behind their cuisine! Better to

How to get there:

From the conference venue, walk 450m to bus station Lindenstr./Oranienstr. Then take bus **M29** direction U Hermannplatz and stop at Pflügerstr. station. The restaurant will be 50 m away from the bus stop. From door to door, the journey takes ca 25 min...but worth it!
