BeNCoRe, the Belgian Network for Coastal Research established in 2006-2007 is a national network bringing together research. BeNCoRe aims at stimulating and facilitating knowledge exchange between network participants both at nation bottlenecks to be addressed are fragmentation of the coastal communities, communication between science, practice a regions and lack of multidisciplinary approaches.

The dissemination of knowledge depends heavily on the language in which documentation is available.

The drafting of articles in English alone is therefore a brake on their appropriation by non-English speakers.

#### Second year achievements


