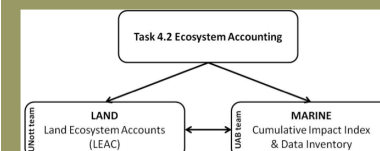

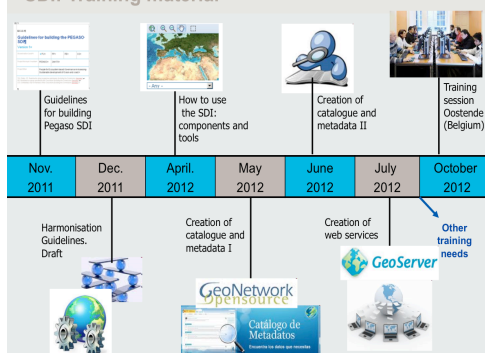

The Pegaso stock-take has been accepted as an official report and a basis for the reporting system of the Barcelona Convention (COP17 decision).

Pegaso progress of work (January-February 2012)

WP2

The paper on governance criteria (input to D2.1.2) is being finalised although there was a low interest in contributing to the issues raised at the Pegaso consortium forum.

Discussion has started on the objectives and contents of the conceptual framework (D2.1B).

10 Mediterranean countries have submitted a revised version of the stock take questionnaire and the information for the Black Sea is almost finished.

The UAB assisted to the International Meeting on Water and Wetlands in the Mediterranean organised by Najib Benessaiah, a member of the Pegaso end user committee and the Medwet coordinator. The main goal was to explore the opportunity to build up interactions between Pegaso and the water and wetland networks.

WP3

A few changes have been made in the 1st training material for building the Pegaso SDI. The new version of the document has been uploaded to the Pegaso intranet.

A moodle e-learning platform has been created to organize the training materials. The training materials will be organized in five stages that will end in a face-to-face meeting in Oostende on the 22nd to 25th of October 2012.

Work continues with the development of the harmonization guidelines and the proposal of administrative units to use.

WP4

Important progress was made during these two months over the WP4 tasks LEAC, Scenarios, and Economic Assessment.

The ID4.3.1. "Review of existing scenario studies" and the ID 4.2.2 "Report on LEAC Methodology for coast and marine accounts" have been uploaded to the Pegaso consortium forum for comments.

Task 4.2 will constitute two components. One of these components will be an ecosystem accounting tool that will be developed for the land environment using the LEAC methodology (to be developed by the UNOTT team). As this method still needs development in order to be applied to the marine environment, the other component of Task 4.2 will be the production of a cumulative impact index for a number of crucial coastal/marine ecosystems (to be developed by the UAB team). The final version of the Cumulative Impact Index (CIM) concept note for the Mediterranean and Black Sea Basins has also been uploaded to the Pegaso consortium forum.

The Pegaso work on Accounting and indicators (WP4) was presented in

the EEA meeting "Development of coastal and marine/fish ecosystem accounting frameworks" (Copenhagen, 10th of February 2012).

WP5

The WP5 focuses on the evaluation phase number 2 and the answer to the question "what do we expect from the CASEs?" It should be something precise in the view of the Regional Assessment. A well structured set of information:

Coastal issues and social political relevance using indicators from 4.1, Relevance of coastal issues, Aims of their job and relation with tools, Lessons learned in trying to adopt the tools and Data available for the indicators.

WP6

The Capacity Building Plan has been produced and validated by the Steering Committee. The WP6 leaders will update the CBP with the changes proposed within the SC to be able to upload the document in the Pegaso intranet for information to the Consortium.

WP7

The Bulletin No 3 is published; the work towards preparation of Poster No 2, Bulletin No 4 and Brochure for Decision Makers is underway together with the revision of the Communication Plan.
